

Functions of Statistical Coordination Group of the 2030 Agenda in Latin America and the Caribbean

- Provide strategic leadership in the process of implementing the SDGs in the region, with regard to indicators measurements, statistical monitoring and reporting.
- Support the development of a regional SDG indicators framework which considers the different realities, emphasis, and common challenges faced by the countries of Latin America and the Caribbean.
- Promote national ownership of the regional monitoring framework of the 2030 Agenda and encourage capacity building, cooperation and coordination to ensure consistency between the regional and global dimensions.
- Promote the use of international statistical standards and methodologies.
- Address issues related to strengthening statistical capacities in the region.
